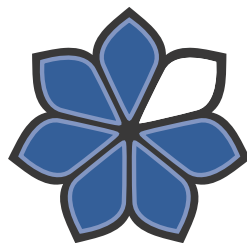


Facts About the Blues Babe Foundation



- Founded in 2002 by Grammy-winning singer/songwriter and poet **Jill Scott** to provide financial support and mentoring for urban students who have shown the aptitude and commitment to their education, but whose families may not have the resources to ensure completion of their undergraduate degrees
- **“Blues Babe”** is the affectionate nickname of Jill’s grandmother.
- Initial focus will be on helping students from distressed areas of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Camden, New Jersey; and the Delaware Valley.
- The Foundation focuses on youth, ages 16-21, through a variety of initiatives.
 - Annual scholarship program for a selected high school’s graduating seniors.
 - Support for local community focused, non-profit organizations.
 - Cause-related programming geared towards urban youth
- Activity highlights to date:
 - In the spring of 2003, the Blues Babe Foundation made a donation of over \$60,000 to the graduating class of the Creative Arts High School in Camden, New Jersey. In 2005, school will be renamed the Jill Scott High School.
 - In 2002, in conjunction with E! Entertainment Television, the Foundation donated desktop computer systems to Philadelphia’s Meredith School, Jill’s elementary school.
